Obituary

Pastor Alice M. Morris-Roberson was born in Naples, Texas on May 11, 1931, to Mrs. Annie Smith and John Henry Morris. Pastor Roberson was a true woman of God who gave her life to the Lord at the age of 8 years old being baptized at Morning Star Baptist Church during a revival.

For five years she was Assistant Pastor at True Gospel Church of God in Christ under the leadership of Ellis Leo Wright and after his death she became Pastor for 15 years and served as Associate Pastor at the Beauty of Holiness NTPC until her health no longer permitted her under the leadership of Bishop Cleven Washington, Sr. She had read the entire Bible twice and still read it daily. She preferred to read the King James Version. She believed in The Father, Son and the Holy Ghost and in the Baptism name of the Father, Son, and the Holy Ghost in the Name of Jesus Christ.

Alice was a motivated teacher of the gospel for over 74 years. Her skills included public speaking, creative problem solving and an advanced level of motivational encouragements. She was able to communicate effectively with a team and was very keen on developing more professional skills, such as teaching, healing, prophecy, discernment, wisdom, and understanding.

She attended and graduated from Westport High School in Kansas City, Missouri in June 1967; Penn Valley Junior College, Associates Degree, June 1971; UMKC, Bachelor's Degree, May 11, 2019; Faith Bible College, She was to receive an Honorary Master's Degree on May 11, 2020.

Alice was preceded in death by her mother Annie Smith, father John Henry Morris, sister Mary Warren-Henderson, brothers J. T., L. B., and Otis Morris, her son Hosea Lee Warren, Sr. and grandson Hosea Lee Warren, Jr. She leaves to mourn grandchildren Tim Matthews, Alicia Mills, Precious Warren and 15 great-grandchildren, a niece Alice Warren-Carter, Great Niece Sha Shun Warren and a host of other beloved relatives and friends.
