### Obituary

Our Beautiful Althea On the morning of February 17th, 2022, Kansas City lost one of its greatest champions for environmental justice and community service.

Althea Marie Moses, born on November 13th, 1967, was a classy and phenomenal woman who embodied the Christian ideals of faith, love, and compassion. She served as the Environmental Protection Agency's Environmental Justice Coordinator for Region 7, which included the Kansas City metro area, for 30 years and was awarded a Lifetime Achievement Award among others for her service.

Althea also served as a part of Jamison Memorial Temple C.M.E.'s music ministry and children's ministry for over 20 years. When Althea was not working and advocating for people, she enjoyed baking cakes for her family and people in need and gardening at her home and church. Everyone will remember her unforgettable smile and her exemplary walk with faith she had while suffering from the illnesses and injuries she sustained from a stroke she had in November 2020. She has been survived by her husband of 30 years Marcus M. Moses, her children Malcolm M. Moses, Micah M. Moses, McKenzie M. Moses, her soon to be daughter in law Kaielle Valentine, her parents Rev. Dayton Smith, Sr. and Mrs. Cornetta J. Smith, and her five

siblings Andrea Anderson, Blanche Smith, Cortonio Smith-Myles, Yolonda Adams, and Dayton Smith, Jr.
