



## Antione Armstrong

July 31, 1959 - November 23, 2017

Antione Armstrong, lovingly called by his family as "Deacon Antione" was the ninth child and a fraternal twin born July 31, 1959, to the union of Warren and Veola Bullock Armstrong at Kansas University Hospital of Kansas City, Kansas. A Season to die- Antione Armstrong departed this life at home and began his Heavenly journey on Thursday, November 23, 2017, on Thanksgiving Day. He was preceded in death by his parents, and three brothers, brothers Michael Armstrong, Keith Armstrong and Warren Armstrong-Jabali. member. Antione loved attending Worship Services, Bible Study and was an active member of the Sunday School Class Number Three (3) and the Greeters Ministry. He also loved to bowl, travel, and attend parades, musical concerts and all other activities and events that allowed him the opportunity to socialize in rain, sunshine, sleet, or snow.
