Archie attended Lincoln High School before serving his country by joining the Marines in 1962. He retired from the United States Army in 1998 after 28 years where he worked as a Maintenance Supervisor. Archie was a professed believer in Jesus Christ, was baptised at age 16, and was a member of Sunlight Missionary Baptist Church, where he served as a deacon in training until his health no longer allowed him to serve.
