Mrs. Aser Lee (Edward) Brownlee slipped quietly from this life into everlasting on October 14, 2019 in Kansas. She was born on May 17, 1928 to Julia McNairy and John Edwards in Aberdeen, Mississippi. Aser Lee Brownlee, Willie Thomas, and Alma Jean Price, lovingly known as “The three Amigos”. These women were like sisters. They lived in the Armstrong Community, attended church together, and now they’re with The Master in Heaven.
