Obituary

Carolyn Hall, age 76, of Kansas City, MO, peacefully passed away on July 23, 2021 surrounded by loved ones, after a difficult battle with Parkinson's.

Carolyn was born on October 3, 1944 to Charles and Emogene Bryant in Kansas City, MO. After Carolyn graduated from Central High School in 1962, she pursued a degree in Mathematics at University of Missouri - Columbia.

After graduation, she worked as a high school mathematics teacher at Paseo High School for four years, but ultimately found her true passion as one of the first African-American female programmers at AT&T, where she worked over 40 years.

In the early 1970s, Carolyn met Joe Emerson Hall at a birthday party hosted by mutual friend, Brenda Rowe. Joe & Carolyn went on to have one child, Latifa.

Carolyn retired in 1998 after 40 years in the field. While retired, Carolyn had time to pursue her love of baking and scrap booking. In 2017, she moved to Washington, DC, to live with her daughter and grandson, but forever remained a loyal and faithful Kansas City Chiefs and Royals fan.

Carolyn was predeceased by her parents, Charles and Emogene, and her husband, Joe. She is survived by her daughter, Latifa; grandson, Malachi; brother, Charles Bryant Jr. of Atlanta, Georgia; sisters, Betty Smith of Kansas City, Missouri and Vania (Anthony) Allen of Atlanta, Georgia; sisters-in-law, Sarah Hall and Margie Johnson both of Kansas City, Missouri; and a host of nieces and nephews.
