Chester Al-Sweeney, Jr., 65, passed away on June 29, 2021, at Truman Medical Center.

Chester Arthur Lee Sweeney Jr. was the first son born to Arthur L. Sweeney Sr. and Thelma I. Sweeney on March 19, 1956 in Kansas City, Mo., and transitioned June 29, 2021 at 65 years of age. He was affectionately referred to as "Junior" by the family. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Chester attended the Kansas City School District and was an alumni of Central Sr. High School Blue Eagles class of 1974. He was an alumni of Beloit College and Northwestern University. Chester liked to work helping people, with decades of service to mentally challenged and troubled youth. He achieved certification as Certified Cisco Network Associate and held employment at Gateway Computers and also worked as a Real Estate Salesman for Caldwell Banker.

Chester went back to people service and worked several years as an EMT on ambulances, over 13 years for The Kansas City School Board and was dedicated employee at the Northwest Regional Youth Center at the time of his death with 15 years of service for the State of Missouri.
