Obituary

Clifford Dale Jackson, 84, passed away on February 2, 2022 at Research Medical Center in Kansas City, Missouri. He was born on October 17, 1937 in Dalton, Missouri to Donald Jackson and Cordia Bell Lyord. Clifford was an only child, but loved spending time with his extended family.

Clifford grew up in Kansas City, Missouri. He graduated from Manual High School in Kansas City, Missouri in 1956. After high school he was drafted into the United States Army and served 2 years active duty and 2 years in the Reserves. He began working for Armco Steel as a machinist where he worked for 20 years. He retired in 1987. Clifford last worked for Kansas City Area Transportation Authority as a bus driver for many years before fully retiring.
