Doris R. Gantt Thompson, born on October 19, 1926, in La Grange, Missouri, peacefully completed her earthly pilgrimage on September 10, 2024. She was the daughter of John and Carrie Gantt, who both preceded her in death. She was the youngest of six siblings who also preceded her in death.

Doris accepted Christ at an early age, which guided her life path and service to others. Doris spent her early education in Quincy, Illinois, where she received her foundational education.
