Dorothy Louise Cameron, age 98, of Kansas City, Missouri, fell asleep in death on Saturday, December 11, 2021, in her home from lung cancer. She was born in Kansas City on November 4, 1923, via midwife, the second daughter of Oliver and Irene Steward from Springfield, Missouri.
