Obituary

Eddie Green was Born on March 1, 1930, in Beaufort, South Carolina, to Ms. Lillian Green. He grew up there with his mother, stepfather (Ezekiel Cohen), 4 brothers (Arthur, Isaac, William, and Ezekiel), and his niece Lillian who was more like a little sister.

As a teen, he spent some time living in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania with his aunt Minnie and uncle Wilfred Whaley who were more like surrogate parents.

On October 24, 1950, he enlisted in the United States Navy where he served his country for 3 years, 9 months, and 25 days. He served on board the USS Randolph during the Korean war as a stewards man, traveling all over Europe. He received an honorable discharge on August 18, 1954.

Eddie Green was a Kosher chef for 50 years! He was a great chef in general and worked hard until his retirement in 2000. Many years of his working life were spent at Applebaum's, a very popular New York City Kosher deli.

During the course of his life, he resided in Beaufort, South Carolina, New York City, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, San Diego, California, and finally, Belton, Missouri where he transitioned very peacefully in his sleep on Sunday, November 13, 2022.

Eddie was married twice and had 10 children. He is survived by 6 of them, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, his little sister Lillian, and his wife, Gloria Green.

Eddie Green was loved by many and liked by almost everyone he met. He loved fishing, playing with his grandchildren, dogs, oatmeal cookies, chocolate with almonds, and watching his favorite baseball team, the New York Mets. He will be missed very much, but he is at peace with our lord.
