



## Mr. Errol T. Bell

### Obituary

Errol Thomas Bell (Tommy) died on October 5, 2022, while in hospice at his home in Kansas City, Missouri. He was born to Ruth Laverne Cooper Bell and Orville Lee Bell Sr. He accepted Christ at the age of 12 at St. Stephens Baptist Church. Preceding him in death were his parents Orville Bell and Ruth Bell, his grandparents Issac M. Cooper and Beatrice Cooper, sisters Donna Bell and Edie Clemons, Minnie B. Bell

Errol graduated from Lincoln Highschool in the class of 1965, Kansas City, Missouri. Following graduation, he attended Los Angeles City College where he studied civil engineering. Errol later enlisted in the United States Navy which he served more than 20 years with an honorable discharge with the rank of AK1.
