They began dating and united in holy matrimony on December 6th 1986. They were married for over 35 years until her death on March 10th 2022. Eugene really liked boxing, to which he had a library of tapes. He loved baseball, the Royals being his favorite team. In his younger days he loved fast cars, going to the drag strip to race his 1961 black Ford four-speed 427, which he called "The Stomping Stallion".
