Floyd Junior Crowley died on August 17, 2023. He quietly departed this life in the comfort of his Lee's Summit home, surrounded by his wife and daughter after a long illness. In the summer Floyd would contact businesses to get donation and he even went to Boys Town to get ponies for the kids to ride. He was a mentor to a lot of adolescents as well as adults during his lifetime.

Floyd was a person who enjoyed life and visiting family and friends. He treasured family above all things after God. Each and every day before each

meal he would say a prayer and if we forgot he would remind us to be thankful for everything that God had given us. Those who knew him witnessed his compassion for others and had heart of gold. If you were in a tight spot and needed assistance, he was there for you. Floyd also had a hot temper if provoked and most people tried to stay away from that side of him.

During his lifetime Floyd worked many jobs. Sold insurance for Mutual of Omaha, home alarm systems for AT&T, Sears Roebuck & Co and John F Lawhon Furniture. He decided to open his own retail furniture store in Blue Springs and later in south Kansas City and called them Floyd's Furniture Barn. After 15 years of operation, he closed the stores to try something new. He decided to try the car business. Floyd was all about making money. He worked for Ray Adams Toyota, Superior Buick Cadillac, Dave Arnold Nissan, and was employed at Stateline Nissan for over 25 years before his passing. Floyd was considered a legend in the automotive industry. As a car salesman he was well known throughout the greater metropolitan area of Kansas City.
