L.C. was a very gifted and special man. He just used all of what God gave him. Henry played at Thanksgiving breakfasts, parties, clubs and concerts. L.C. was one of the best drum players around. He married BeBe Burbs. Henry was preceded in death by his daughter that he loved to pieces, Aldo Gant, Micheal Martins, Kenneth

Martin and step children.
