Ida Belle McClinton Grant was born on April 30, 1936 in Hensley, Arkansas. She was the second of five siblings of the late DeWoody McClinton and Nancy Holland McClinton.

“Belle”, as she was fondly called by her family and other friends from Arkansas, entered eternal rest at Research Hospital on the morning of April 26, 2018, knowing she was loved and cherished.
