She moved to Kansas City, MO her Freshman Year where she attended and graduated from Paseo High School in 1973. During her time there she met and later married, Gerald Franklin Leigh, after graduation and to that union two children were born, Gerald Franklin Leigh Jr. and Crystal Danielle Leigh. She didn't have any particular hobbies, but her favorite past time was curling up on the sofa or sitting in a chair eating Lays potatoes chips, drinking a Coke and reading books. Jackie attended and joined Cain Grant AME Church and was active by singing in the Choir. She often said that her favorite song was "Oh Happy Day". Jackie was employed with AT&T for many years until she transferred to Southwestern Bell where she remained until Retirement. Not wanting to just sit around she gained employment with Seaboard Corporation from 2002 to 2012. In 2010 she married Milton Hicks and in 2012 she retired again moving to Safford, AZ where she and her husband, Milton would live out what she called "the happiest time of her life". In August of 2019, after multiple visits to doctors for what seemed to be "stomach pain", she was diagnosed with Cancer. She was very private about her condition and only shared necessary information to close family. She left this Life and entered into Eternal Life on July 26, 2020 with her husband
