### Obituary

James was born in Kansas City, MO on December 10th, 1943 to his mother, Lois Jackson, and father, Homer Frye. James graduated in 1961 from Lincoln High School and enjoyed a full life.

James served in the United States Army as 4th class Specialist from 1965 to 1967. He was employed with Puritan Bennett for 23 years (1963-1986) and the Federal Aviation Administration for 29 years (FAA, 1986-2015). He was a member of Bethel A.M.E. church and the Voices of Bethel Choir. He also spent time as a vocalist in the McClellan-Akers Singers.

In 1978, at the age of 35, he married his wife, Glenda Fisher (Jackson), and over the course of 50 years together they raised three children – William, Kristel, and Shanté Jackson.

James was diagnosed with large cell neuroendocrine cancer in October 2019 and God called this soldier home to end his pain and suffering in October 2022 at the age of 78.
