Pastor Slaughter grew up in Woodruff County on his family farm in Riverside his father Osborn was a sharecropper and his mother Sallie was a homemaker. he often talk about that he grew up in a house full of love, and they all had a love for God and that he would wake up to the smell of fresh homemade biscuit and fried bacon and how his mother would cook breakfast lunch and dinner daily and how they all would work on the family farm together and love to attend church with his family at Morningview Missionary Baptist Church of McCrory, Arkansas, his journey with Christ begin an early and at the age of 15 he was baptized in a river by the church in Riverside and one of his favorite hobbies was singing in a quartet with his brother Clifton and they would sing in local churches and would travel to a nearby community to

sing which he loves.

Pastor Slaughter was educated in the McCrory, Arkansas School District attended elementary and high school. In 1954 he met and married Effie Mae Brown of Augusta, Arkansas and they were the proud parent of five children Ernest Lee, Sallie Eloise, Edna Earl, J.C. In 1976 he founded and pastor the Morningview Missionary Baptist Church for over 44 years and On October 23, 2020 Pastor Slaughter celebrated 54 years in the ministry.
