### Obituary

Kay Sue Hammonds, 75 years old passed away on March 13 2022 in Hampton, Georgia. She was born on July 30th, 1946 in Kansas City, Kansas to John and Fronie Lee Oglesby.

Kay was born and raised in Kansas City, Kansas; she attended the Kansas City Public Schools. Once Kay completed her GED, she attended and graduated from Kansas City Kansas Community College and obtained an Associates Degree in Nursing. Kay later obtained her BSN (Bachelors of Science in Nursing) from Phoenix University. In 2016, while working towards completing her Master's Degree in Nursing, Kay had a massive stroke, preventing her from completing the program. Kay worked as a registered nurse for over 45 years. She enjoyed the nursing profession and took pride in her work. She worked at various hospitals and nursing facilities. Kay worked at Baptist Medical Center for 15 years and later transitioned to Research Medical Center where she remained until retiring in 2009.

Kay was a woman of great faith and had installed that into her children. She was baptized at Mt Vernon Baptist Church in Kansas City, Missouri by Reverend Emmanuel A. Johnson.

Kay was united in holy matrimony to David Hammonds on April 6, 1974 and

they had two children. They remained married until David's passing in July 2019.

While working as a registered nurse, Kay embarked on being an entrepreneur. In 1990, she was the owner and sole proprietor of Kay Krafts. She had a talent and skills for making various floral arrangements, quilts and other household decorum. Kay was also the proud owner of Hammonds Enterprises — owning and leasing a few dozen single-family homes throughout the Kansas City area.

Kay was also a member of The Kansas City Community Gardens. She was an avid gardener who took pride in her homegrown vegetables, oftentimes sharing with neighbors, friends and family. Above all, she enjoyed spending time with her family and close friends. It was not uncommon for Kay to invite and host holiday dinners and celebrations at her home. Kay loved her family and would do whatever she could to help anyone.

Those who knew Kay will remember her quick humor, ambitious drive and entrepreneurial spirit, which allowed her to reach remarkable achievements. Those who knew her well will remember her charitable, selfless spirit, and for always being willing to lend a helping hand.
