Obituary

Keith Edwin Cobb called “Petey” by his family of Kansas City, Missouri passed away on October 23, 2022 after a long hard fight with metastatic breast cancer. Born August 6, 1955 to Orenzo Cobb and Cora Sue Cobb of Kansas City, Missouri.

At an early age Keith was baptized and joined St. Luke AME Church in Salisbury, Missouri.

After High School, Keith briefly worked for Burlington Northern Railroad after which with the support and encouragement of his big brother, Thomas Mozee, he joined the Kansas City Fire Department where he enjoyed a thirty-six-year career.

In 1985 Keith met his wife, Karla Glasgow-Cobb, they married October 29, 1977 and would have celebrated their thirty-fifth anniversary on October 29, 2022.

Keith was a proud member of Local 42. Firefighting was his passion. In 1997 he received the highest achievable recognition by the Department, the “Award for Valor”. This award was presented to Keith for his heroic act for running back into a burning structure without protective gear to save a man’s life.

Although Keith delighted in all things fire related whether he was driving a fire truck or a pumper, doing underwater rescue, or riding out as Captain, truly his first love was firefighting. As he would often tell his wife how he preferred to work at the fire stations with the “most action” where the chance of getting fire calls were greater.

Keith loved the Chiefs, race cars, boats, horseback riding and fishing especially with his friends. Never one to brag or boast, he loved the Chevrolet Corvette and owned a few in his lifetime. Hard tops and drop tops and when he was behind the wheel all you would see was his huge, beautiful infectious smile.
