Lee Calvin Simms 74, departed this life on Saturday, September 28, 2019 at Village Hospice House in John Knox Village of Lee's Summit, MO. Lee (Tip, as he was lovingly called by his family & friends) was born June 13, 1945 in Altheimer, Arkansas to Carliss Simms and Verlean Bohanon. He spent the earlier part of his childhood in Pine Bluff, Arkansas, being nurtured and loved by his Grandfather, Sammie Simms and Grandmother, Willie Mae [WU1] Simms, along with his Aunt, Carrie Simms and Uncle, James Simms. His nurturing and love continued when he relocated to Kansas City, MO to be raised by his Parents, Morris and Verlean Cunningham.
