Obituary

Queen Lela Elvira Collins was born on September 30, 1930 in Rusk, Texas, to the late Rev. Eli Whitney Wheeler, Sr. and Addie Mae (White) Wheeler. She grew up in rural Elm Grove, Texas, where she attended elementary and junior high school. Lela gave her life to Christ at an early age. Later on, her father accepted a pastoral leadership position, causing the family to move to the Midwest. She went on to graduate from Independence High School in Independence, Kansas class of 1949.

Elvira met the love of her life, Jeremiah A. Collins and married on October 27, 1951. Through their union, six children, 18 grandchildren, 37 great grandchildren and seven great-great grandchildren were born. As a wife and mother, she was an employee of Internal Revenue Service (IRS). Later on, she became a Data Analyst for Trans World Airlines (TWA), where she eventually retired in 1991.

She was heavily involved in her church while serving in every capacity. Elvira was a member of New Zion Missionary Baptist Church, where her brother, the late Rev. Levi Wheeler resided as pastor until his death. Additionally, she was an honorary member of Memorial Church International, under the tutelage of Apostle Larry B. and Pastor Olivia C. Q. Aiken.

At 92 years young, Elvira transitioned in her home surrounded by her earthly and heavenly family on November 9, 2022. She is reunited in love with her husband, Jeremiah "Jerry" A. Collins; her sons, Gary Collins, Sr. and Derrick "Ricky" Collins, Sr., a grandson, Arthur Jaron Collins; her parents, Rev. Eli Whitney Wheeler, Sr. and Addie Mae (White) Wheeler; six brothers, Rev.
