Mamie Lee Wilkerson was born June 23, 1938 to the union of Jerry and Renner Jackson in Somerville Tennessee. Sabrina from birth until they were old enough to attend kindergarten. Mamie was a beautiful soul, often described as one of a kind. Mamie had an open-door policy and provided a safe and loving home for many of her loved ones over the years. She would give her last dollar with a smile and wouldn't expect anything in return.
