Marian F. Hayes was born on March 7, 1936, in Sedalia, Missouri, the beloved daughter of Edward E.

Black and Janie Stapleton Johnson. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, William E.

Hayes; her sister, Dorthene Williams Ivey; and her daughter, Deborah Ivey Glass.

A 1954 graduate of Lincoln Hubbard High School in Sedalia, Missouri, Marian was united in marriage to
