We are celebrating the life of Mother Rose Mary Rowe who was born March 3, 1933 in Augusta, Arkansas to Ivory B. and John Robert Nevels.

Rose received her education in the Augusta Public School System, where she attended Carver High School. In 1954, she was joined in holy matrimony to Theodore R. Rowe. To this union, ten children were born. The only greater love than the love between them is the love of God.

In the early 1950s, Rose and Theodore moved to Kansas City, MO. Mother Rose worked in the laundry service industry at Plaza Ford Ideal for many years. After her husband became ill, she stopped working to become his full-time caregiver.

Mother Rose accepted Christ early in life and loved the Lord—a true woman of God and strong in her faith. She was a member of the Greater Antioch Missionary Baptist Church—which later became Bethlehem Antioch Baptist Church—where she served on the Usher Board. She later united with Fellowship Right Baptist Church—serving on the Usher Board and on the Mother Board. She loved her family and raised her children in church to know God.

Rose was a dedicated wife, mother, and grandmother first and foremost. She treasured her children and embraced every moment with them. She especially enjoyed her role as “Grandma.” Mother Rose had a flair for cooking; her food would just melt in your mouth and was accentuated by any extra dash of love. In addition to cooking, her favorite pastimes included traveling with her family, going to the casino with her sister Lula, and watching the Kansas City Chiefs at home with her children and grandchildren. She had a warm and caring spirit and always made people feel welcomed and loved—one of the sweetest people you ever would meet. Committed to her family and community, Mother Rose will be remembered as a devoted mother, grandmother, great grandmother, aunt, sister, cousin, and friend.
