### Obituary

He would never complain about anything. He never met a stranger and would wave at anyone while he would drive down the street. It didn't matter whether he knew them or not, and he always was willing to help anyone.

On June 2, 1974 he dedicated his life to Jehovah God and was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses. He remained faithful until his death. Two of his favorite scriptures was Revelation 21:3,4 where he often read "sickness and death will be no more" and John 5:28,29 that speaks about the promise of a resurrection. He placed his hope in that resurrection.
