As a founding member of Foe-B-Low Michael played an intricate role as producer and vocalist, with the assistance of Sean Timmons and numerous other collaborators. Michael has collaborated and performed with artists like Vell Bakardy, Tech N9ne, E-40, and a host of legendary Artists and Bands.

Michael had an incredible love of music and art, he started his first production and management company and helped produce some great talent in Kansas City. He was very big on producing anyone in his family that had the same love for music, his brother, Ronnell Jameson and daughter, Zakiah Booka Jameson was part of his proudest moments as he helped produce them. His art and drawing was showed in his son, Zion. His intelligence of business and work ethic was passed down to his daughter, Zhyesia. One of Michael's most treasured memories was when he headlined a performance at The Black Expo.

Michael was a believer in Jesus Christ and would often acknowledge that he was blessed by God to do some of the many things he was able to do. He was a devout family man and enjoyed spending quality time with his family. He was always there with financial support, his presence or just mere comforting words. He will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.
