Mother Connie V. Packnett, 85, passed away on January 24, 2021 peacefully at home in Kansas City, Missouri.

Mother Packnett was born on February 8, 1935 in Centreville, Mississippi to Superintendent James Cason and Clarissa Dennis Cason.

Mother Packnett grew up Centreville and graduated from Finch High School in 1954. After High School Mother Packnett married Deacon John Packnett on July 24, 1954, and they were happily married for 60 years. In this union they had one son Pastor Thuston Packnett of whom they were Godly proud.

Mother Packnett was a member of Beulah Land Church of God In Christ in Centreville, Mississippi where her Father, Superintendent James Cason was the Pastor. After moving to Kansas City, she became a charter member of Holy Temple where Bishop C. N. Rucker was her Pastor. Mother Packnett faithfully served as Financial Secretary, Sunday School Leader, and Pulpit Worker. She also served as District Y.P.W.W. Chairlady in the Central Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction. After the passing of Bishop Rucker, she continued her faithful service under the leadership of Dr. J.C. Haynes.

In 2002, Mother Packnett joined Redemption Ministries where her son is the Pastor. Again, faithfully serving until her health failed. Even with failing health Mother Packnett would pop up and sing "Get up from there sitting down... God can't use you sitting down".

Mother Connie Packnett retired from Macy's Department Store after 18 years of service. After retirement needing to stay busy she worked at Wylies's Grille in South Kansas City.

Mother Packnett was preceded in death by her parents Superintendent James and Mother Clarissa Cason, her loving husband Deacon John Packnett, four brothers; Carey Cason, Leslie Cason, Levall Cason, and Deacon James Cason, Jr.; three sisters, Johnnie V. Packnett, Supervisor Hattie Mae Salisbury, and Missionary Ida Arbuthnot.
