### Obituary

Mylon was the secretary of the Well-Seasoned Seniors Club, a member of Brush Creek Community Center, a member of Vineyard Neighborhood Association and a volunteer at Harvesters. She was loved for her outgoing personality and wonderful sense of humor.

She has taken her final bow and stood for the last curtain call.
