Nathan Lewis Wash was born on May 9, 1959 to Henderson Wash and Ernestine (Foster) Wash in Kansas City, Kansas . He is preceded in death by his parents, Henderson and Ernestine Wash, and sister, Anita McKeithen.

He attended Central High School from 1974-1978. Upon graduation in 1978 he pursued an extended career in the military. In October of 1978, Nathan enlisted in the army. He worked finance at Fort Lee before going overseas to finance in Germany and France. He then came back to the states where he continued his role in finance for the National Guard. Nathan retired in 2006, and moved back to Kansas City, Missouri where his home and heart was. He accept Christ at an early age and was a member of the Metropolitan Missionary Baptist Church. He was caring, loving, and empathetic. He would give his last to help someone in need. He also had a very inquisitive mind. From dissecting crime shows and puzzles, to creating his own his meticulous way of organizing, he remained hungry to learn new things and expand his vast intellect.

Nathan departed this life on December 17, 2023, at the home.
