Nathanne Patrice "Mickie" Johnson, 52, of Belton, Missouri, passed away peacefully on Sunday, March 29, 2026, after a courageous and grace-filled battle with pancreatic cancer.

Mickie was born on May 18, 1973, in Kansas City, Missouri, to Nathaniel Johnson, Sr. and the late Barbara Evette Titus. As the youngest of five, she held a special place in her family—loved deeply, protected fiercely, and known for the warmth and light she brought into every room.

Mickie was united in marriage to Arthur Lee Mackey, Jr, and from this union she was blessed with her beloved son, Justin Mantez Mackey. To know Mickie was to love her. But to be her son was something truly extraordinary. She was a devoted and loving mother to Justin Mackey, her heart and her greatest joy. Their bond was unbreakable, filled with laughter, inside jokes, shared moments, and a deep friendship that so many admired. From their fun-loving Facebook posts to their cherished monthly brunch dates, they created a lifetime of beautiful memories side by side.

Mickie's faith carried her throughout her life. She accepted Christ at an early age at Christian Tabernacle COGIC and continued her spiritual journey at New Life in Christ and The Worship Center. Her faith was quiet yet powerful seen in her strength, her kindness, and the way she loved others so

effortlessly.

She was a proud graduate of Ruskin High School, Class of 1991, and went on to earn her Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Missouri–Kansas City, followed by two master’s degrees from Webster University. Mickie’s determination was unmatched—balancing full-time work while continuing her education. She dedicated her professional life to serving others through her work at Children’s Mercy Hospital, the VA Hospital, and most recently at University Health, where she served as the Senior Manager of Medical Education in the Medical Education Department.

In 2004, Mickie was initiated into the Lambda Epsilon Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, at the University of Missouri–Kansas City—an affiliation she held with deep pride and sisterhood, especially alongside her line sisters Stephanie Devonish, Aisha Augusta, Ph.D., and Tameka G. Mickie had a spirit that was simply beautiful. She was gentle, loving, and genuine—a woman who made people feel seen, comfortable, and cared for. She loved to travel, enjoyed dancing (especially a good two-step), and somehow always managed to capture the perfect picture. Yet her greatest joy was found in the simple moments—being at home, laughing with family, and creating memories with those she loved most.

She was preceded in death by her mother and stepfather, Barbara E. and Hubert Titus; her brothers, Namon Thompson, Jr. and Everett Johnson; and her cherished sister-friend, Charnaë Thomas.
