It is with deep sorrow that we announce the passing of Oneita Darnella Walker, beloved, wife, mother, and grandmother, who left us on May 21, 2024, at the age of 72.

Born on July 18, 1951, in Kansas City, Missouri, Oneita Darnella Walker lived a life full of love, compassion, and dedication to her family and community. Her life was a testament to the strength and beauty of the human spirit. She was known for her unwavering love and support for her family, always putting their needs above her own. Her kindness and generosity touched the lives of many.

She continued her service to the church under the leadership of Reverend Joseph Fletcher where she was a part of the Dance ministry, Trustee ministry, served as an instructor on the Usher Board, as a Sunday School teacher, and as a church financial clerk.
