Reverend Paul Edward Fowler Sr. was born to Amizeri and Sadie Fowler on November 1, 1932 in Kansas City, MO. After spending most of his youth in the KCMO area, and in Tonganoxie, KS with his Material Grandma Brown, he enlisted in the United States Navy in 1951, serving on the USS Platte. Rev. Fowler was very proud of his time in the service and kept a picture of the USS Platte near his chair. Sometimes you would catch him staring at the photo reminiscing of some of his adventures. After his service career he moved back to the KCMO area, where he worked as a maintenance engineer and mail room clerk for over 40 years at Haas and Wilkerson Insurance Company.

On March 26, 1955 He united in marriage to Betty Anne Coleman. To this union 5 children were born. He loved to take his family on road trips across the country, spending a lot time in the Rocky Mountains of Denver, CO.

On August 27th, 2000 Reverend Paul E Fowler Sr. accepted the calling to become an ordained Minister of the Gospel. Rev. Paul was an associate minister at Mt. Tabor Missionary Baptist Church, where he served faithfully. He loved to share the word of God, with all that crossed his path.
