



## Ms. Pearlle Mae ((Woodley)) Allen

### Obituary

Pearlle Mae Allen was born on December 29, 1938 in Tunica, Mississippi to the parents of Pecolia and Clifton Woodley. She was the sixth of eight children born into this union. She is preceded in death by her father and mother, brothers Clifton Woodley, Jr., Robert Woodley, Jesse Woodley and Jimmy Woodley; sister, Buelah Moore; sons Cecil Allen and Terrance Allen.

As a youth Pearlle confessed Jesus Christ as her personal Savior. She used her Christian teachings to influence others. Pearlle was a soprano tenor with the “Silvertones” gospel group in Tunica, Mississippi which consisted of her sisters and cousins. Her personality and charisma drew people to her and she was the light of the room. She enjoyed telling jokes.

Pearlle was an employee for Allied Signal, formerly Bendix in Kansas City, Missouri for over 15 years where she retired in 1997. She was well liked by peers and coworkers and left a lasting impression with them.

In January 1995, Pearlle and her eldest daughter Doris Allen had the opportunity to rescue two members of the Harlem Globetrotters escape from a large crowd of autograph seekers at a local shopping mall. Can you imagine two seven-foot basketball players inside a small vehicle? Transporting them back to their hotel safely, receiving two unexpected tickets for the scheduled

game that night.
