### Obituary

Phillip Scott, 64, was the third child born to Myrtle Scott (Bailey) on January 6, 1959, in Kansas City, Missouri. After a nearly three year well fought battle with cancer, he departed this life on February 13, 2023. He was preceded in death by his father, Reuben H. Bailey; his maternal grandparents, Rev. John and Nellie Scott; his sister, Sharon Scott, and his oldest brother Kenneth Scott.
