Ray Carroll Sr. was born on March 31, 1957 in Vicksburg Mississippi to Lula M, Carroll and Calvin Freeman. (Both who preceded him in death).

Ray grew up in Kansas City, Missouri. He attended Central high school before joining the Job Corp in Ogden, Utah and Chadron, Nebraska where he received his GED and Concrete Finisher Certification.
