Rita Janelle Norman Lang was born to the union of Judge R. Norman Jr. and Loretta Elsenia Neeley Norman at Douglass Hospital in Quindaro, Kansas on September 16, 1954.

She received her education in the Kansas City Kansas School District 500 graduating from Washington High School Class of 1972. She played Clarinet in the Marching Band and excelled in sewing class where her clothing projects were displayed in the Showcase.

Growing up in a Christian musical family, at the age of 3 she began singing in the Children's Choir at First Baptist Church of Quindaro. At 12 years old, Rita was baptized and became a lifelong member of First Baptist. She continued singing for the Lord in the Junior and Senior Choir, and also at many weddings.
