Obituary

Roy Lee Broadus was born in Kansas City, Mo on November 23, 1942 to Mary Katherine Broadus. His stepfather, Millard Crout, who raised him preceded him in death. He attended Wendell Phillips Elementary School, Lincoln Junior High School, Lincoln High School, and Central Missouri College. Roy married Donna Carolyn Ray in 1962. From this union came Carolyn Michelle and Yvette Monique Broadus. They later divorced. Roy was drafted by the U.S. Army, took basic training at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo.

He attended Jump School at Fort Benning, Georgia. Food Service School at Fort Lee, VA. He was stationed at Ft. Greely, Alaska for two weeks of cold weather for warfare training. Roy served two years in Vietnam of which 6 months in Food Service and 18 months in Infantry where he received numerous medals. Roy worked in many capacities at Bendix, Kansas City Dressed Beef Co. and at Lake City Army Ammunition Plant for 34 years. From a relationship with Jacqueline Johnson, LaTonya Johnson was born. Roy married Bobbie Jean Burt on November 23, 1972.

From this union, Ha'Son Broadus was born. The later divorced. Roy married Denise Lemmones, from this union Roy L. Broadus II was born. In 1994, his wife, Denise, died of cancer. Roy was preceded in death by his mother, Mary K. Crout, one daughter, Carolyn Michelle Broadus-Smoos, two sisters:
