



## Mr. Warren C. Kelly

May 27, 1947 - August 28, 2025

Warren Calvin Kelly, affectionately known as “Butch,” entered eternal rest on August 28, 2025, at The Madison Senior Living in Kansas City, MO, surrounded by his loving family.

Warren was born on May 27, 1947, in Fayette, Missouri, to Marie Shipley-Kelly and Harry Kelly. He was welcomed into Heaven by his parents, and by his beloved sisters, Melba “Toast” Gordon and Diana Kelly.
