Reverend William H. Vaughn, Sr.,? Howard,? 92, was born on September 27, 1925, in Fulton, Missouri to the late James E. and Ethel Smallwood Vaughn. Reverend Vaughn departed this life on November 26, 2017. He was preceded in death by his brother Robert Eugene Vaughn, two sisters, Juanita McBride and Mary Louise Wiggins, a daughter, Ethel Savvoir, and two sons, Dr. J. Douglass Vaughn-Harris and William Vaughn, Jr. Reverend Vaughn graduated from Lincoln University High School in Jefferson, Missouri. In 1943, he relocated to Kansas City, Missouri and graduated from Western Bible College and then attended St. Paul Theological Seminary. He was ordained into the Ministry at Pleasant Green Baptist Church in Kansas City, Missouri. During his lifetime he was employed by General Motors, American Restaurants, Holiday Inn, and Westin Crown Center. Reverend Vaughn united with Christ at an early age. He loved baseball and football. Howard played Shortstop for the Monarchs in 1946-1947. He pastored Log Providence Missionary Baptist Church in Columbia, Missouri. Howard was united in marriage to Katherine Vaughn in April of 1966 and enjoyed fifty-one years of marriage. At the time of his passing, he was Pastor Emeritus at Pleasant Valley Baptist Church where he had served for over thirty-seven years with a church family that he loved very dearly.
